

Agbro has presented solo exhibitions, large-scale installations, and received funding at institutions across the Pacific Northwest including MadArt Studio, Bainbridge Island Museum of Art, The Gates Foundation Discovery Center, 4Culture, Artist Trust, Shunpike, The Neddy Foundation, and Pratt Fine Arts Center, among many others.

"The core of my work is about unseeable systems, but the figurative forms are ultimately about projection and the ways perception is manipulated by social structures. This series explores how isolation—both structural, social isolation and personal experiences of solitude— affects our relationship with society. Specifically, how this plays out in public, where countless unspoken rules, codes, or expectations dictate social norms. Norms have a profound effect on our public selves. It is in public where we decide whether to conform or descent, where we witness the successes and failures in the lives of others, and where we begin to unpack our own beliefs. But the understanding of value through public experiences can breed detachment. The more intimate we are with the greater society, the more we feel alienated from it." - Jite Agbro


