



### **AUDRA WEASER** "LIGHTFALLS"

Audra Weaser spent childhood summers in the Pacific Northwest and turns to its dynamic and dramatic landscape as inspiration for this collection. With an ongoing interest in the play of light on water, here Weaser presents shimmering, layered surfaces that echo the atmospheric and prismatic colors of the Northwest's abundant misty waterfalls. Weaser's process of sanding through layers of paint, effectively creates the dynamic space between the power and reflection inherent in these forces of nature, provoking an emotional, internal response in the viewer and an invitation to deeply immerse themselves in the work.


