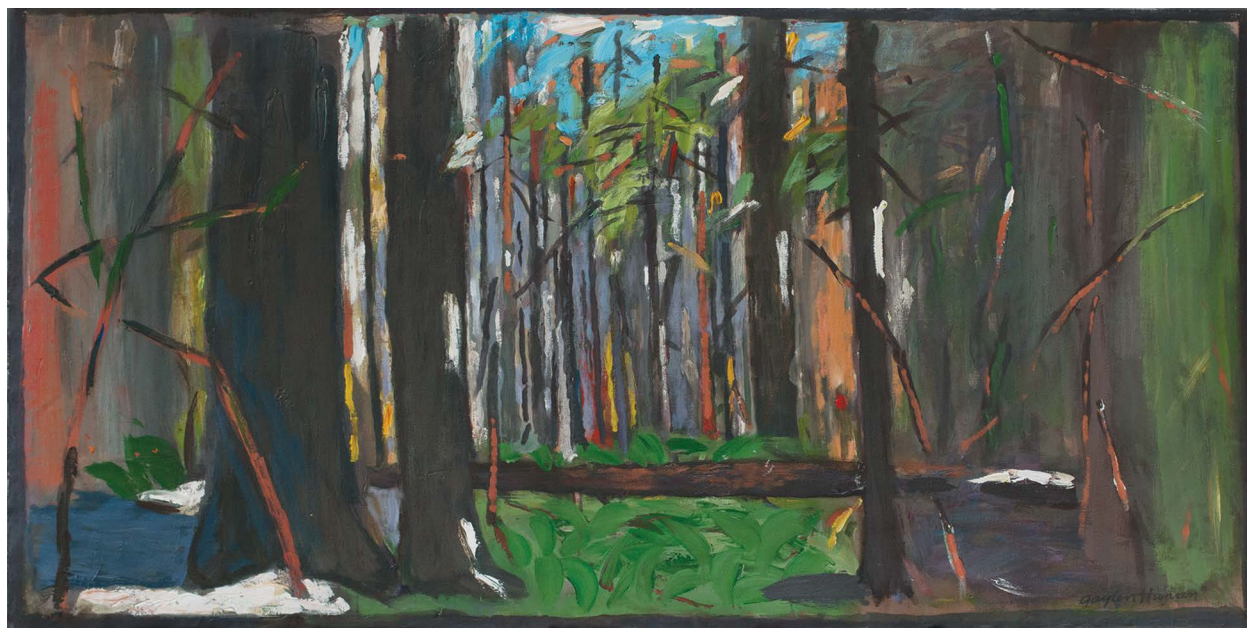

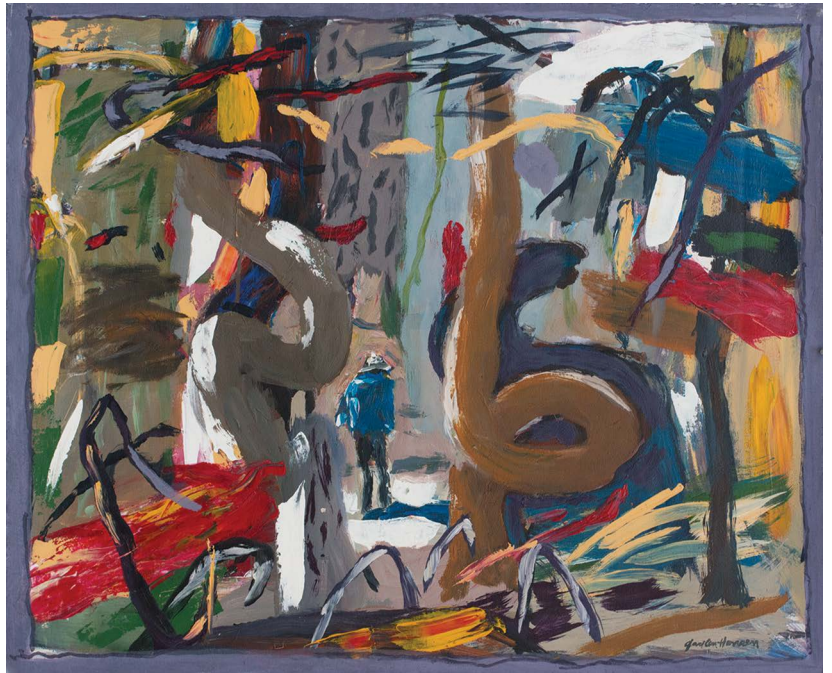

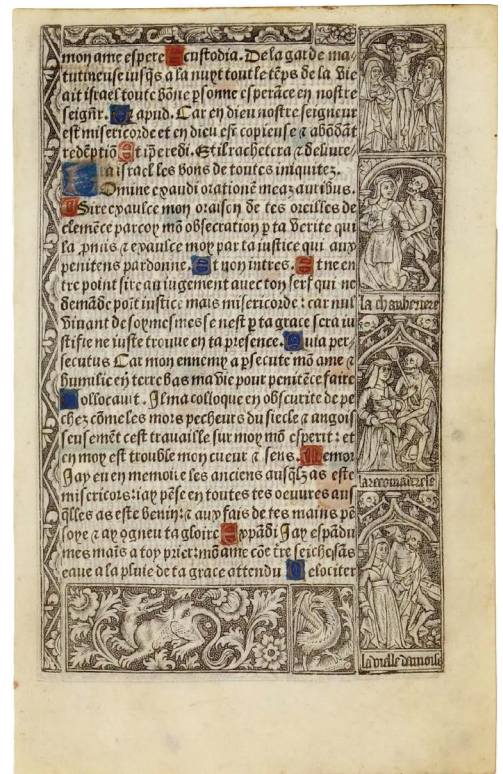

Susie Wind- *Sky*, oil, 36 x 36, 2023



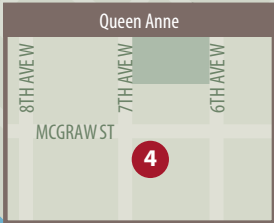
